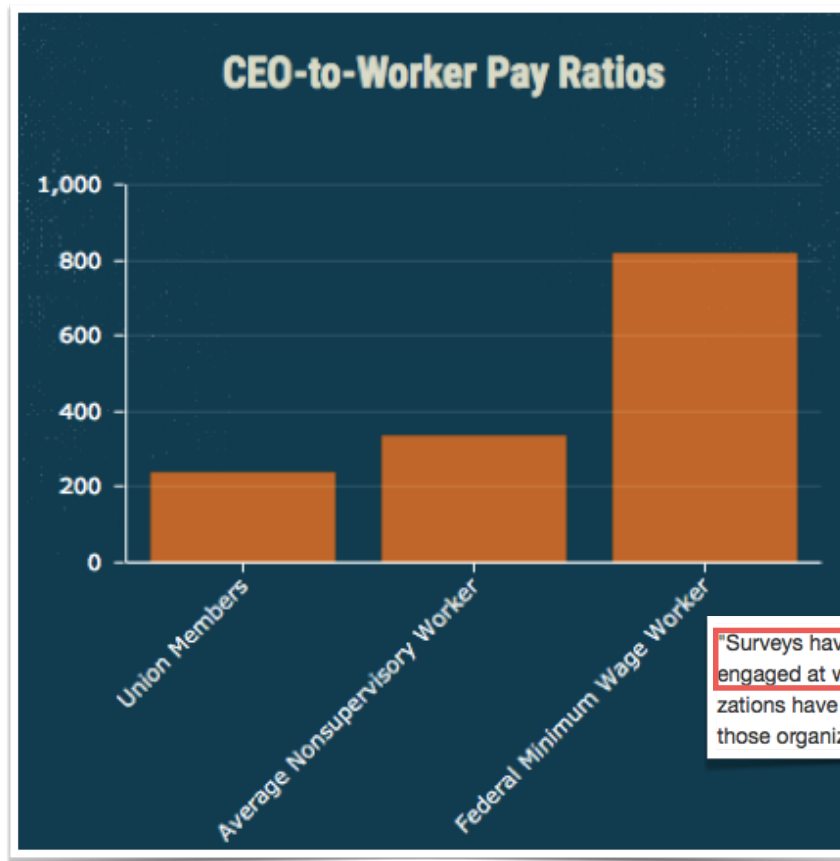


Extreme Financial Inequality as Social Cancer
