


Eliminate the Digital Divide 2014-15 Grant Program

#### DESCRIPTION

The Eliminate the Digital Divide grant program seeks to provide access to computers, telecommunications technologies and related training to disadvantaged communities. Under this program, the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) is authorized to award grants of up to \$75,000 to plan, establish, administer and expand Community Technology Centers (CTC's) and to support basic computer literacy training programs.
